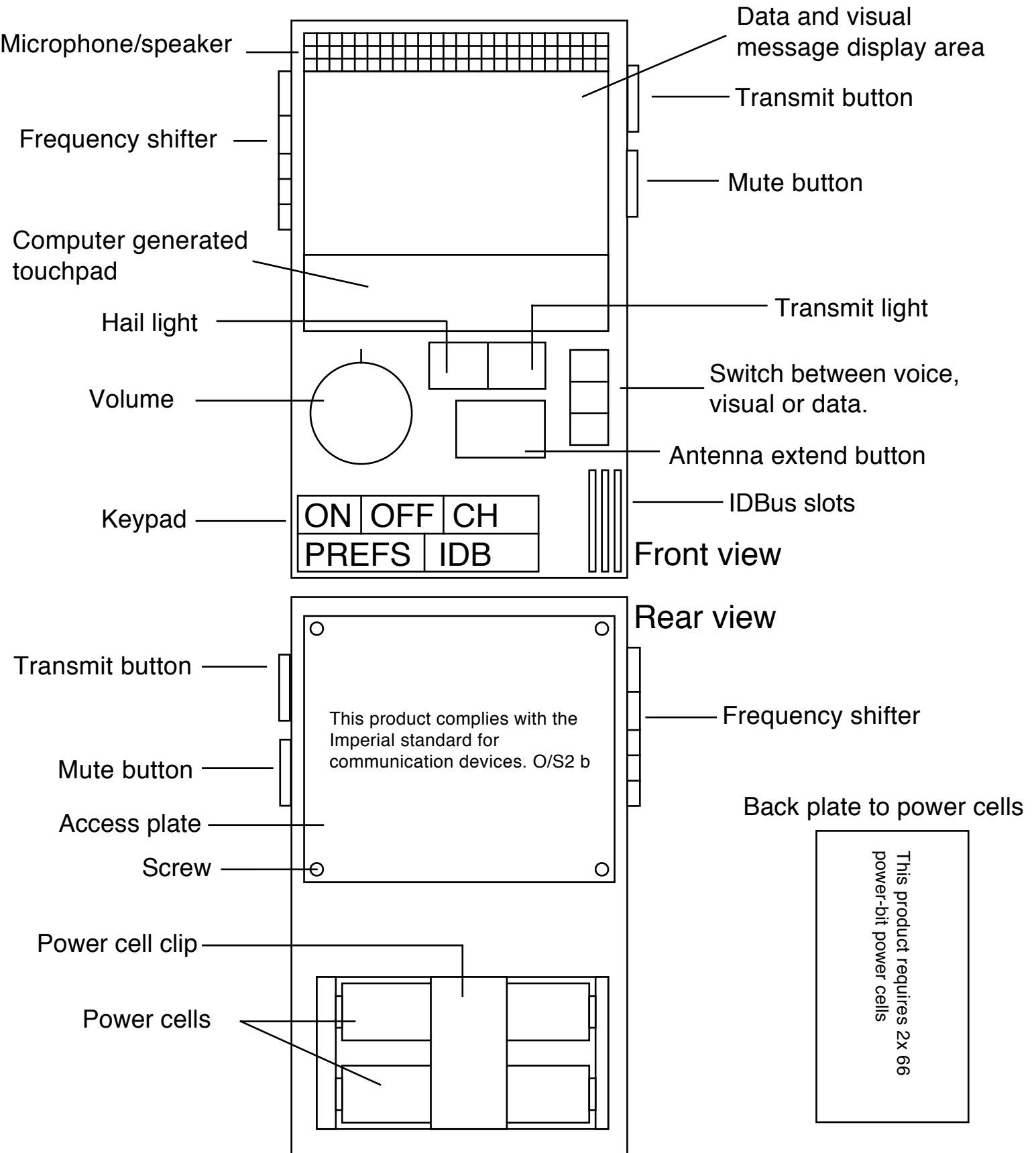


Imperial lascomm

The Imperial lascomm is basically a communications device. It uses the same technology as lasguns but the beam is a lot less powerful.



There are 3 modes on the lascomm. The first is normal voice messages, second is visual transmission and the last one displays the message on the screen. There are 3 IDBus slots for transferring preferences, chooser or pre-set frequencies files to the disk. The top 2 buttons on the shifter cycle through all frequencies. The bottom 3 are for pre-set frequencies. The power cell clip simply holds the power cells in place. The on and off buttons turn the lascomm on or off. CH stands for chooser, PREFS for preferences and IDB stands for IDBus clips. The touch pad displays whatever buttons are used in that mode.
